
**INTENDED ACTION:** Amend

**330-X-1-.01 Purpose.** The Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was created to protect the public by helping to safeguard life, health and property, and to promote the public welfare by providing for the licensing ~~and regulation~~ of persons in and regulation of the practices of engineering and land surveying. This purpose is achieved through the establishment of minimum qualifications for entry into the professions of engineering and land surveying, through the adoption of rules defining and delineating unlawful or unethical conduct, and through swift and effective discipline for those individuals or entities who violate the applicable laws or rules promulgated thereunder.

**330-X-1-.03 Officers/Board Members.**

(1) Election. The Board shall elect annually the following officers: Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary.

(2) Compensation and Expenses. Board Members shall be compensated on a per diem basis for days actually spent in performance of their duties and, additionally, members of the Board shall be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in performance of their duties as provided by Section 34-11-32 and Section 36-7-20 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

**330-X-1-.05 Executive Director.** The Board shall employ an Executive Director who shall be responsible for the administration of Board policy. The Board may also employ an Assistant Executive Director. The Executive Director is designated as agent for the Board for service of services including any legal process upon the Board.

### **330-X-1-.07 Meetings.**

(1) Meetings may be called by the Chair or by a quorum of the Board.

(2) Each member of the Board shall be given at least seven days notice of the time, place, and purpose of for any regular or special meeting, by the Chair or the Executive Director, unless such notice is waived by the individual member or unless such member is present at the called meeting at least 24 hours notice for a special meeting, and at least 1 hour for an emergency meeting. The notice will include the time, place and purpose of the meeting.

(3) The Board shall hold at least two regular meetings each year and these meetings shall be held in Montgomery, Alabama. Special and emergency meetings may be called as necessary and may be held at any place agreed upon by a quorum of the Board.

(4) The Executive Director will ensure that reasonable notice to include time, date, and place is given to the public for all meetings the meeting notices comply with Alabama's Open Meeting Act, Section 36-25A, Code of Alabama, 1975.

**330-X-1-.08 Questions of Procedure and Evidence.** The Except as otherwise provided in these rules, the Chair of the Board shall in accordance with these rules, and except as otherwise provided in these rules, rule upon all questions of procedure and, in the event that evidence is taken, on the admissibility of that evidence. The decision of the Chair shall be final.

### **330-X-1-.11 Records.**

(1) Public record, for the purpose of these rules, means all Board records which are reasonably necessary to record the business and activities required to be done or carried on by the Board so that the status and condition of such business and activities can be known by will be available to the public. The results of disciplinary hearings are considered public records. Records which do not constitute public records include, but are not limited to, those received by a public officer in confidence, sensitive personnel records, licensee's records, examination material for examinations not yet given, file records of examination problem solutions, applicant's records, application references, complaints against licensees and nonlicensees, investigative files where investigation is pending, and records the disclosure of which would be detrimental to the best interests of the public.

(2) Public records are available for inspection at the Board office during regular business hours.

(3) Any person wishing to obtain copies of public records may request such copies from the Executive Director, and will be supplied copies upon payment of the cost of copying, handling and postage, which costs will be estimated and set by resolution by the Board.
