### CHAPTER 330-X-8 EXAMINATIONS

#### 330-X-8-.10 Examination for Record Purposes.

- (1) Any engineer licensed by this Board may take for record purposes the Fundamentals of Engineering Examination and the Principles and Practice of Engineering Examination prepared by NCEES upon payment of a fee as established by the Board of the fees to NCEES.
- (2) Any land surveyor licensed by this Board may take for record purposes the Fundamentals of Surveying and the Principles and Practice of Surveying Examination prepared by NCEES upon payment of a fee as established by the Board of the fees to NCEES.
- (3) Failure to pass either or both parts of the examination will in no way affect current licensure.
