Requirements for Election Officials Regarding Affidavit for Voter Who Fails to Bring Acceptable Photo Identification to the Polling Place.

Identification that allows an election official to "positively identify" the voter as that term is used in Code of Alabama, 1975, section 17-9-30 (e) (2011) cannot be established by any method or means other than the election official's personal acquaintance with the voter that allows the election official to state with certainty and with no doubt or reservation that the voter is who he/she says he/she is.

In order to sign the affidavit promulgated in Rule 820-2-9-.11 attesting that the election official has positively identified a voter as a voter on the poll list who is eligible to vote, the positive identification must be based on the election official's personal acquaintance with the voter that allows the election official to state with certainty and with no doubt or reservation that the voter is who he/she says he/she is.
