SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The above referenced rule is being amended to better address the application of the Alabama Medicaid Agency Adult/Pediatric Inpatient SI/IS (Severity of Illness/Intensity of Services) Care Criteria in reviewing and approving coverage of additional days once an OB (obstetrical) recipient has exceeded the 16 inpatient days.

## Rule No. 560-X-7-.25 Prior Authorization

- (1) Out-of-State Referrals Prior authorization will be required for organ transplants and select surgical procedures. (Refer to Rule No. 560-X-1-.27 and Rule No. 560-X-6-.13 respectively).
  - (2) Dental Hospitalization See Chapter 15, Dental Services, for details.
- (3) Additional inpatient days for deliveries, beyond the initial days paid may be authorized upon request for recipients who have exceeded their initial 16 paid days.
- (a) A ten digit authorization number will be issued for those stays that are medically necessary and meet the Alabama Medicaid Adult and Pediatric Inpatient Care Criteria.
- (b) Additional days other than for <u>induction</u>, <u>onset of labor</u>, delivery, and inpatient postpartum care will not be authorized.
