RULE NO. & TITLE: 390-X-6-.01 Training Required For Certification


INTENDED ACTION: To amend the rule.

CHAPTER 390-X-6
PRESCRIBED BURNING CERTIFICATION AND PRESCRIPTION

390-X-6-.01 Training Required For Certification. A training program ~~will be~~ has been established to meet the training requirements of the Alabama Prescribed Burning Act. In order to be certified, candidates must complete the training course sponsored or approved by the Alabama Forestry Commission and apply for certification within two years of completing the training course. This course will include discussion of fire behavior, burning methods, safety, planning, smoke screening and Alabama fire laws.
