**80-8-5-.02 Referendum To Be Held.** A referendum shall be held by the Association certified by the Board of Agriculture and Industries, under the provisions of Code of Ala. 1975, §2-8-234, on a statewide basis at which time Alabama producers of wheat, corn, grain sorghum, and oats may vote, upon the question of whether they favor an assessment of \$.01 per net bushel after deductions for foreign matter on any feed grains sold by said producers during the period beginning on November 16, ~~2006~~ 2011, and ending on November 16, ~~2011~~ 2016, for the purpose of financing a promotional program for grains as authorized by Code of Ala. 1975, §2-8-246.
