Substance of Proposed Action: To renew the period during which feed grain is sold in regards to Persons entitled to vote in the referendum.



Persons Entitled To Vote.

(1) All persons subject to the deduction of \$.01 per bushel from the sale price of their feed grains are entitled to vote in the referendum upon the question of whether they favor an assessment of one cent (\$.01) per bushel to be deducted from the sale price of their feed grains sold during the period beginning November 16, 2006, 2011 and ending on November 16, 2011 2016, provided such persons produced feed grains in 2005 2010 or planted feed grains for harvest in 2006 2011.

(2) Each feed grains producer shall have one vote where the production operation is conducted by an individual, partnership, corporation, estate or other legal entity. If the feed grains production operation is conducted as a family enterprise and different members of the family produce feed grains which are sold separately, each such producer is entitled to one vote. If the feed grains production operation is conducted by a partnership, corporation, estate or other legal entity, then one individual shall be designated to vote for such a production operation. Where feed grains are produced on lands of another, on a share crop or share tenant basis and such share cropper receives feed grains which he sells, then such share cropper is entitled to vote in the referendum.

(3) Each eligible voter shall vote in person at an established polling place. Proxy voting or voting by mail shall not be permitted.
