INTENDED ACTION:

The Alabama State Board of Occupational Therapy proposes to amend the above rule.

SUSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

The Alabama Occupational Therapy Practice Act authorizes the Board of promulgate such regulations as are needed to enforce the provisions of Act 90-383, codified as 34-39-1, Code of Alabama 1975, which makes illegal, except in certain specific instances, the practice of occupational therapy without a license and requires the licensure of all persons desiring to practice occupational therapy. This rule is being amended to exclude issuance of a limited permit to those persons who previously failed the certification examination.



Limited permits shall expire 120 days after issuance or upon notification of failure of examination by the National Board of Certification in Occupational Therapy with the exception of those issued for traineeship/perceptorship. ~~No more than one limited permit shall be granted per applicant if the applicant has failed the examination.~~ Limited permits are not renewable.
