RULE NO. & TITLE: 750-X-2-.02 Application Deadlines


INTENDED ACTION: The Alabama Board of Examiners in Psychology proposes to amend the above rule.

750-X-2-.02 Application Deadlines. Upon request, all persons intending to apply for licensure will be supplied with a licensure application form, a copy of the Alabama law, **and** an “Information for Applicants” brochure **and a computer-based- testing (CBT) application. Applicants who are required to take the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP) will complete the computer-based-testing application.** The cut-off dates for completion of application files will be the first day of odd numbered months, to be reviewed at the Board’s next regularly scheduled meeting.
