Each merit scholarship will be in the ~~amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per annum and is eligible for renewal for a maximum of four (4) years or a total of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000)~~ an amount not to exceed the current annual cost of tuition at the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Optometry provided the recipient maintains an accumulative academic average which ranks in the upper twenty percent (20%) of his/her class. These are awarded without regard of financial need to bona fide residents of Alabama.
