FEES (REPEAL)

Rule 610-X-4-.14 Fees.

- (1) Fees and fines are not refundable. Fees are valid for only 12 months from date of receipt.
- (2) Fees are payable by certified check, cashier's check, corporate or business check, money order, personal check, or electronically via debit or credit card when available.
- (a) Counter checks are not an acceptable method of payment. Personal checks shall be imprinted with the name, address, and account number of the applicant or licensee.
 - (b) Personal checks by third parties are not acceptable.
 - (c) Personal checks on out of state banks are not acceptable.
- (d) License verification fee(s) are not payable by personal check. Fees for the voluntary disciplinary alternative program (VDAP) are not payable by personal check.
- (e) Applicants or licensed practical nurses or registered nurses who submit personal checks that are returned due to insufficient funds may be prohibited from paying any future fees or fines by personal check.
- (f) Statutory charges for returned checks shall be paid by the applicant or licensed practical nurse or registered nurse.
- (3) Fines are payable by certified check, cashier's check, corporate or business check, money order, or electronically by debit or credit card.
- (4) The Board may allow payment of fees and fines solely by electronic means.
- (5) Payment, regardless of the method, that is not honored by the financial institution may result in disciplinary action and/or reporting to the appropriate legal authorities for possible prosecution.
- (6) A license may not be issued until funds are received by the Board.
- (7) The Board shall set fees and charges annually. At each September meeting of the Board, the previous schedule of fees and charges shall be automatically readopted unless the Board proposes a revised schedule.

Rule 610-X-4-.14 Fees

- (1) Fees and fines are non-refundable.
- (2) Fees are valid for 12 months from date of receipt.
- (3) Fees and fines may be paid by electronic means using a credit or debit card if available. Other means of payment may be cashier's check, business check, money order, or certified check.
- (4) Personal checks are only acceptable when the individual applicant or licensed nurse's name is imprinted on the check. Personal checks that are not acceptable forms of payment are:
 - (i) Counter checks.
 - (ii) Third-party checks.
 - (iii) On out-of-state banks.
 - (iv) Fees for license verification and Voluntary Disciplinary Alternative Program (VDAP).
 - (v) Fines.
- (5) Payment, regardless of method, that is not honored by the financial institution may result in disciplinary action and reporting to the appropriate authorities for prosecution.
- (6) The statutory bad check charge applies to any personal check returned by the financial institution for insufficient funds.
- (7) The Board shall set fees and charges annually. At each September meeting of the Board, the previous schedule of fees and charges shall be automatically readopted unless the Board proposes a revised schedule.
